

Montreal, June 22 — (AP) — Mrs. Sarah E. Smith Scollard, wealthy United States real estate speculator, died at the Mount Royal Hotel here July 24, 1932, Dr. W. E. Johnson, of the hotel, stated tonight.

He said she died after four days of illness due to bronchial pneumonia, and he issued a death certificate. July 24 was Sunday, Dr. Johnson recalled, and Mrs. Scollard died at noon.

The woman lived alone at the hotel. Dr. Johnson said she had told him that Reese Brown, her attorney, would look after all expenses and correspondence.
